Highly detailed anterior composite restorations require specifically designed instruments to properly manipulate and contour the material, especially along the cervical margins.

The Gold Grip Esthetic Contouring Instrument makes anterior composite restoration easy! Features a convex-shaped paddle that allows you to spread composite across the facial plane for diastemas, Class IV, and Class V restorations. The convex surface has no edge to catch and pull the composite, allowing for a smooth composite-to-tooth transition.

► Clinical Technique







The convex paddle of the Gold Grip Esthetic Contouring Instrument is a sturdy, curved spoon shape, the back of which is ideal for shaping the curves of lingual concavities. The front side is used to form the curvature at the gum line or interproximal surfaces on the lingual side and may also be used to carry restorative composite material, such as Evanesce,™ to the preparation.





The long, flat, thin, flexible blade of the Gold Grip Esthetic Contouring Instrument is spatula-shaped and designed for use on facial surfaces of maxillary incisors, buccal surfaces of posterior teeth, and where there is a large, rounded surface. It is excellent for adapting a gum line margin and ideal for forming a gentle curve toward interproximal spaces and the tooth's edge for esthetic highlighting.
